Creative writing: Creating our own Dinosaur, describing movement, appearance, sound and character.

Poetry: Dinosaur poems.

Narrative: Write an exciting story set in the land before time.

Daily Phonic sessions, and handwriting.

Maths

R Counting, ordering and comparing numbers. Practice and develop oral and mental skills. Estimating. Problem solving. Beginning to solve practical problems using addition and subtraction. Weight and length. Pattern and shape. Begin to count in twos and tens.

Y1/2 Addition/subtraction facts. Tens and Units. Problem solving. Oral/mental calculations. 2/3D shape and symmetry. Collect and record data. Read a scale.

We will be writing our own songs to describe what they may have made or heard. Then we'll choose instruments to accompany our lyrics.

Pulse, beat, tempo, rhythm - what do these words mean. We will use a variety of instruments to experiment with beat, rhythm and tempo.

Art / DT

Exploring Materials: We will use different materials to create dinosaur images including pastels, charcoal, paint, collage and ICT.

We will be making our favourite dinosaur and an environment for it to live in.

ICT

Use internet texts to gather information for our reports in Literacy.

Use ICT as a way of producing dinosaur art work and texts to be included in our information books.

Science

We will be looking at what the Dinosaurs ate, how they moved and their similarities and differences. (Variation)

We will be doing lots of sorting based on our own criteria and look at the Triassic, Jurassic and Cretaceous periods.

We will explore fossils.

We will also be looking at and growing plants.
