French

Listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding ▪ explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes. Develop accurate pronunciation and intonation so that others understand when they are reading aloud or using familiar words and phrases. Broaden their vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new words that are introduced into familiar written material, including through using a dictionary. Begin to write phrases from memory and adapt these to create new sentences, to express themselves clearly.
